We read in scripture, when God gives someone a special task, he gives them a new name for the mission with which he is entrusting them. God's plans and stories do not end in scripture. YOUR story is part of God's plan too and when you receive the sacrament of Confirmation, you are sealed with the Holy Spirit...and God sends YOU on a new mission. What do you think your mission will be? What gifts has God given you so far, that he will strengthen at Confirmation? God will also give you gifts at Confirmation that you do not yet possess.

To accomplish this mission, you will need a friend in faith with whom you can connect and will provide you inspiration. You will find your parents to be important role models, as well as your Confirmation Sponsor; they are surely praying for you during your Confirmation preparation journey. You must have a conversation with Jesus and ask him to help you discern what he desires from your co-mission with him; just remember a conversation is two ways...you need to talk...*and listen!* And you will also need to find a friend in faith from someone who has lived a holy and good life on earth, and who can pray for you from heaven; a Saint. You should choose your Confirmation Name after the Saint with whom you make a connection and whom inspires you; someone you would like to emulate. This Saint can be someone the Church recognizes as a saint, but it can also be a Catholic person you know who's earthly life has ended, and who now lives with God.

Your Confirmation Saint's Name Report must be:

- > One, to one and one half, pages total; consisting of 3 6 full paragraphs
- Single spaced
- > Font: Times New Roman; size 12
- > Margins: 1"
- > Include a Bibliography at the end of the report, or on it's own, final page
- > 750 words or more
- Do not overuse adjectives to increase your word count (ex. Very, very old) ③
- > Written in complete sentences, including the use of grammar and punctuation to the best of your ability
- Out of the highest awe and respect, God, Jesus, Holy Spirit and Trinity, must always be capitalized or your report will be returned to you as incomplete.
- In your own words (as a reminder: Cutting and pasting is plagiarizing; Plagiarizing is stealing; Stealing is not only illegal, but it breaks the 7th Commandment and is a sin.) We do check for plagiarism and plagiarized reports will be marked incomplete and returned to you.
- > You may choose your first name, your middle name or a completely new name
- > Regardless of your gender, you may choose a male or a female Saint name
- > You should discuss your chosen Saint's name with your parents
- > You must complete your report at home

- B. Name at least one way this Saint showed love for others.
- **C.** What special virtue (a virtue is a good habit that enables a person to act with moral excellence, according to God's will) did the Saint have (talents, faith and love of God, service to others)?

E. How do you relate to this virtue in your own life? ______

F. How will you strive to grow in holiness towards this virtue?
